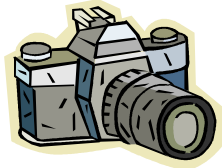

Judging:

The judges will award \$50 to winners in each of the above categories, and a grand prize of \$300 shall be awarded to the overall best entry. Honorable mention ribbons will be awarded. Winners must submit the digital image by e-mail (sjohnson@asumh.edu) or CD to claim their prize.

Deadline:

Completed application, payment and entry must be delivered by February 15, 2010, to any First National Bank location in Mountain Home, Flippin, Gasville, or Lakeview.

- All photographs must originate from a digital camera. No digital scans of traditional prints, slides, or negatives are allowed. No professionals please – this is an amateur contest. Selling photographs or photography services in a previous career does not disqualify the entrant. Previously submitted photographs for this contest are not eligible. Employees of FNB and ASUMH ARE eligible to enter the contest.
- Individuals may submit multiple entries – use a separate form for each submission. Three photos entered in three categories would cost \$15. A single check may be written for multiple entries.
- Prints must be mounted on foam display board and the image must be 8x10 inches in size – no more than 1/2 inch tolerance in size will be allowed. Entries must be mounted on white foam board with no border and with specific mounting hardware. All local framing shops know of this requirement and will mount photographs to comply with this standard. All submissions must be mounted by one of the local shops. Your **printed name, category and image title** must appear on the back. No identifying marks may appear on the display side. Image titles should be six (6) words or less, such as “Beautiful spring day” or “Dangerous waters.”
- The Contest entrant should select a proper category. If the image has been extensively modified by Photoshop or other image editing software, then it should be entered into the Creative category. If only minor adjustments have been made to the image, or if some distraction has been removed, the entry may be entered into any category. Grandchildren entries must have been taken by a grandparent.
- Works submitted will be screened by the Contest Committee. An entry may not be displayed for one or more of the following reasons: (1) display space limitations (2) acceptability of image subject matter (3) adherence to mounting and display standards (4) failure to follow Rules & Regulations.
- Entrants agree to hold Arkansas State University Mountain Home (ASUMH) and First National Bank & Trust harmless for damaged, lost or stolen prints.
- Entrants agree to allow public display, Web site publishing, newspaper printing or any other educational/promotional use of submitted imagery. Entries will be on public display at ASUMH, First National Bank and Trust and the Baxter County Library for several weeks – check the asumh.edu Web site for the schedule. All photos may be retrieved on June 1st at First National Bank (across from Wal-mart location). After two months, contact Wilson or Johnson to retrieve entries. Unclaimed entries may be discarded after one (1) year. Winners must submit the digital image by e-mail (sjohnson@asumh.edu) or CD to claim their prize.
- Entrants pledge that the submitted work comes from their digital camera and they have exclusive legal rights to the image. Photographers retain all rights, other than those mentioned above, to the submitted image.
- The list of rules and regulations are not exclusive or fixed – additions and amendments may be necessary to promote and preserve the good intentions of the contest.
